☐ **Book Creator:** Make a digital book that can contain text, images, drawings, audio recordings, and videos.



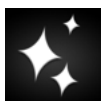
☐ **Stick Around:** Create sorting, matching, and labeling puzzles.



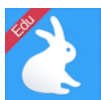
☐ **Explain Everything:** Create videos made by recording what you say as you draw on the screen.
